Glossary

Aide: noun; an assistant or helper.

Correspondent: noun; a person employed by a news agency to gather, report, or contribute news or articles regularly from a distant place.

Dedication: noun; a ceremony marking the official completion or opening of a public space.

Distinction: noun; marked superiority or eminence.

Embassy: noun; a group of people entrusted with a mission on behalf of a government.

Impressed: verb; to affect deeply or strongly in mind or feelings; to influence in opinion.

Journalist: noun; a person whose professional occupation is to report, write, edit, photograph, or broadcast news.

Spanning: verb; to extend over or across a section of land or a river.
