**Glossary**

Amateur: noun; a person who engages in a sport, study, or other activity for pleasure rather than for financial benefit or professional reasons.

Bar: noun; an examination, which when passed, qualifies one to practice law

Competed: verb; to strive to outdo another for acknowledgment or a prize; engage in a contest.

Legacy: noun; anything handed down from the past, as from a predecessor.

Preferring: verb; to like or choose better or rather than.

Reputation: noun; a publicly recognized name or standing for merit, achievement, or reliability.

Temperament: noun; an individual's character, disposition, and tendencies as revealed in his reactions.

Tournament: noun; a trial of skill in some game, in which competitors play a series of contests.
