**Glossary**

Ambitious: adjective; having an earnest desire for some type of achievement or distinction and the willingness to strive for its attainment.

Dismay: verb; to dishearten thoroughly; to fill with discouragement.

Embarked: to start an enterprise, business, some new venture.

Inflation: noun; a progressive rate of increase in the general level of prices.

Reform: the improvement or amendment of what is wrong, corrupt, or unsatisfactory.

Resigned: to give up an office or position, often formally.
