Glossary

Curriculum: noun; the regular or particular course of study in a school or college.

Domestic: adjective; of or pertaining to the home, household, household affairs, or the family.

Emphasized: verb; to lay stress upon; stress.

Finishing: noun; educational or social polish; the quality of being completed with elegance.

Flourished: verb; to be successful; prosper.

Governess: noun; a woman teacher employed in a private household to teach and train the children.

Industrial: related to the nature of manufacturing or technically productive enterprises in a particular field.

Inherited: verb; to receive as if by succession or will, as an heir.

Institutions: noun; an organization, foundation, or society devoted to the promotion of a particular cause or program, especially public, educational, or charitable.

Liberal: adjective; of or related to an education that aims to develop general cultural interests and intellectual ability.

Thrives: verb; to prosper; be fortunate or successful.
