**Glossary**

All-American: adjective; selected as the best in the United States, as in a sport.

Heisman Trophy: noun; an annual award, named for coach John W. Heisman, given to the outstanding college football player in the United States by the Downtown Athletic Club of New York City.

MVP: noun; an acronym for Most Valuable Player.

NFL: noun; an acronym for National Football League, a professional group of football teams, which compete chiefly among themselves.

Recruiter: noun; one who engages in finding and attracting athletes to a sporting team.
