**Glossary**

Synagogue: noun; a Jewish house of worship, often having facilities for religious instruction.

Anti-Semitism: noun; discrimination against or prejudice or hostility toward Jews,

Reminiscent: adjective; awakening memories of something similar; suggestive.

Integration: noun; the free association of people from different racial and ethnic backgrounds.

Segregation: noun; the policy and practice of imposing the separation of ethnic groups.

Lynching: noun; the crime of putting a person or persons to death, especially by hanging, by mob action and without legal authority.

Editorials: noun; articles in a newspaper or other periodical presenting the opinion of the publisher, editor, or editors.

Acquitted: verb; to clear of wrongdoing or absolve of a charge by judicial process.

Moderation: adjective; without excess; within reasonable limits; temperately.
