**Glossary**

Astute: adjective; of keen penetration of discernment; clever, ingenious, or shrewd.

Buffer: noun; a person or thing that lessens shock or protects from damaging impact or circumstances.

Namesake: noun; a person or thing named after another.

Persuaded: verb; to induce to believe by appealing to reason or understanding; convince.

Prematurely: adverb; occurring or existing before the normal or expected time; impulsive or hasty.

Quarreled: verb; to disagree angrily; squabble.

Succeeded: verb; to follow or replace another by descent, election, or appointment.
