Byline; noun, the name of the author of an article in a newspaper or magazine, printed at the head of the article

Dubbed; verb, to give somebody or something a nickname: to give a descriptive nickname to somebody or something.

Pulitzer Prize; Annual awards by Columbia University. Prizes in Letters are for books published in the US - fiction, biography, general non-fiction, history and poetry.

Manuscript; noun, author's original text: an author's text for a book, article, or other piece of written work as it is submitted for publication
