Glossary

Chief Justice: noun; Judge presiding over the highest court in that colony

Invested: verb; to spend money on something in the hope of a future return or benefit

Treaties: noun; a formal contract or agreement negotiated between countries or other political entities

Frontiers: noun; the part of a country with expanding settlement that is being opened up by hunters, herders, and other pioneers in advance of full urban settlement

Dampened: verb; to deaden or stifle something, or become deadened or stifled

Erupted: verb; to burst out suddenly or violently

Evacuated: verb; to empty a dangerous or potentially dangerous place of people
