Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Secretary of State	Noun	United States government official in charge of foreign affairs.
Attorney General	Noun	the chief law officer of a state, and its government's chief legal adviser
Appointed	Verb	Officially give someone a political office/job
Negotiated	Verb	to attempt to come to an agreement on something through discussion and compromise
Annexed	Verb	To take over a territory and incorporate it into another political entity. In this case to absorb a geographic area to a country.
Showdown	Noun	A confrontation to settle a conflict or dispute
