Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Pentecostal	Adjective	belonging or relating to any Christian denomination that emphasizes the workings of the Holy Spirit, interprets the Bible literally, and adopts an informal demonstrative approach to religious worship
Trademark	Noun	a distinctive characteristic associated with a person or group of people
Nonsensical	Adjective	having no sense or meaning
Undertones	Noun	Underlying quality or element, something that is suggested or implied rather than stated openly
Phenomenon	Noun	A fact of occurrence that can be observed
Pompadour	Noun	a man's hairstyle in which the hair is combed back off the face to form a mound above the forehead
Horrified	Verb	to make somebody feel horror, disgust, or fright
Architect	Noun	somebody who creates or invents something
