Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Advertised	Verb	to publicize the qualities of a product, service, business, or event in order to encourage people to buy or use it
Desperate	Adjective	In great need; wanting or needing something very much
Miraculously	Adjective	Extraordinary, thought of as caused by supernatural intervention. Defies the laws of nature
Recognition	Noun	the act of identifying somebody or something on the basis of a past sighting or experience, the ability to do this, or the fact of being identified through having been seen or experienced before
Horrific	Adjective	Very disturbing or frightening – enough to cause horror
