<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Pan	Verb	In this case it refers to things working out. Reference to panning use to sort through dirt for minerals
Plantation	Noun	a large estate or farm, especially in a hot climate, where crops such as cotton, coffee, tea, or rubber trees are grown, in the case of antebellum south worked with slave labor
Inventive	Adjective	Skilled at inventing, good at creating new things
Revolutionized	Verb	to cause a radical change in something such as a method or approach
Profitable	Adjective	yielding a financial profit
Concept	Noun	something that somebody has thought up, or that somebody might be able to imagine
Interchangeable	Verb	Parts that can change places, or easily be replaced.
