Vocabulary

<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Denounce	Verb	to criticize or condemn something publicly and harshly
Segregation	Noun	the practice of keeping ethnic, racial, religious, or gender groups separate, especially by enforcing the use of separate schools, transportation, housing, and other facilities, and usually discriminating against a minority group
Controversial	Adjective	Causing an argument, provoking strong disagreement or disapproval
Interracial	Adjective	The intermixing of two different races
Racism	Noun	prejudice or animosity against people who belong to other races
Sexism	Noun	discrimination against women or men because of their sex
Repelled	Verb	to make somebody feel intense aversion, disgust, or revulsion
Shackles	Noun	Restraints, the modern version of shackles is handcuffs
