Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Popular	Adjective	Well – liked; liked by a person or group of people
Romanticized	Verb	to make something seem or believe something to be more glamorous or ideal than it really is
Imagination	Noun	the part of the mind where ideas, thoughts, and images are formed
Miraculous	Adjective	apparently contrary to the laws of nature and caused by a supernatural power
Balked	Verb	to hesitate over something or be unwilling to do something, usually because of moral scruples or a natural aversion
Fretted	Verb	To be worried, irritated, or agitated
Negotiations	Noun	the reaching of agreement through discussion and compromise
Debuted	Verb	to show or perform formally and publicly for the first time, or make something do this
