Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Religious Liberty	Noun	The ability to practice your religion freely as long as it does not harm others
Migrated	Verb	to move from one region or country to another, often to seek work or other economic opportunities
Ordained	Verb	to appoint somebody officially as a priest, minister, or rabbi
Institution	Noun	a large organization that is influential in the community
Convention	Noun	a group of people or in this case churches who have a common interest or profession
Advocate	Verb	to support or speak in favor of something
Endowment	Noun	an amount of income or property that has been provided to a person or institution, especially an educational institution
