Vocabulary

<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Architect	Noun	somebody who creates or invents something
Opposed	Adjective	Disagreeing with or taking an active stance against somebody or something
Appeasement	Noun	the political strategy of calming a potentially hostile nation in the hope of avoiding war, often by granting concessions
Tyranny	Noun	oppressive government by one or more people who exercise absolute power cruelly and unjustly
Worldview	Noun	The way a person sees and interprets the world. A person's worldview impacts the way they react to events in their life.
Theater	Noun	A specific region where military operations occur during a war or armed conflict
Diplomatic	Adjective	showing tact and skill in dealing with people, especially in dealing with foreign relations
Cold War	Noun	the hostile yet nonviolent relations between the former Soviet Union and the United States, and their respective allies, from around 1946 to 1989
Escalation	Verb	To become or cause something to become greater, more serious, or more intense
