Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Equality	Noun	The state of being equal, rights, treatment, quantity, or value equal to all others in a specific group
Grant	Verb	To give
Degrees	Noun	a title awarded by a university or college following successful completion of a course of study or period of research, or a similar title granted as an honor
Chartered	Adjective	Having been granted a charter, a formal document incorporating an organization, company, or educational institution
Progressive	Adjective	Forward thinking, advocating social, economic, or political reform
Coursework	Noun	work that is assigned to students as part of an educational course and counts toward the grade given for the course
Equivalent	Adjective	Equal, being the same, or effectively the same as something
