Word	Part of Speech	<u>Definition</u>
Freedom	Noun	a state in which somebody is able to act and live as he or she chooses, without being subject to any undue restraints or restrictions
Memoir	Noun	a biography or an account of historical events, especially one written from personal knowledge
Devised	Verb	to conceive of the idea for something and figure out how it will work
Daring	Adjective	showing a courageous or reckless disregard for danger
Trousers	Noun	Pants
Heartfelt	Adjective	Coming from strong and sincere emotion
Gratitude	Noun	Feeling thankful
Bounty	Noun	A reward of money for capturing a person
